Undergraduate courses

Associate Diploma of Ministry, Diploma of Ministry, Advanced Diploma of Ministry, Bachelor of Theology - eight units per year is full time

\$774 per 15 point unit (the standard unit)

\$516 per 10 point unit

\$3,096 per semester full time; \$6,192 per year full time

Graduate courses

Graduate Certificates, Graduate Diplomas, Master of Theological Studies, Master of Divinity, Master of Arts in Theology - six units per year is full-time

\$1,032 per 15 point graduate or postgraduate unit (the standard unit)

\$688 per 10 point graduate unit

\$3,096 per semester full time; \$6,192 per year full time

Tuition fees are charged for Graduate Diploma in Ministry Residential Schools, and for the professional supervision unit (Advanced Counselling 2) in the Graduate Diploma in Counselling.

Masters' Degrees by Research

Full time study

\$6,192 (over three semesters - \$2,064 per semester)

Part time study

Minor thesis candidates: \$1,032 for each of two postgraduate units, **plus**

\$1,032 per semester over four semesters (research)

Major thesis candidates: \$1,032 per semester over six semesters.

Doctoral degrees

Doctor of Philosophy, Doctor of Ministry Studies, Doctor of Theology

Full time study:

\$23,970 over six semesters (\$7,990 per year)

Part time study:

DTheol, PhD: \$1,997.50 per semester over twelve semesters

DMinStuds: \$23,970 minimum, as follows:

- \$1,032 per Qualifying unit (two units - candidates with MMin)
- Collegium, Residential School (candidates with MTheol)
- Comprehensive Assessment (all candidates)
- Doctoral units (two - all candidates)
- Doctoral Seminar (all candidates)
- Supervised Research Project Panel

Transcript Fees (all awards):

These transcript fees are for each award, complete or incomplete, for which a certified transcript is required. The fee includes one laminated and two unlaminated signed and dated copies, on transcript paper.

Transcripts sent to individual addresses, cost for first copy as stated above, additional copies \$10 per copy.

Signed black and white transcripts for students due to graduate are supplied at no charge (granted they have completed the course requirements). If students request for official MCD transcripts, the regular \$50 charge applies. Enrolled undergraduate students can be referred to their RTIs for any records.
